Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label Brut NV

Well known for both its full-bodied style and its consistency. Crisp, full flavoured with good concentration and a long, fruity aftertaste.

Sauvignon Blanc, Ladera Verde

Clean, grassy fruit with fresh acidity. A small amount of Semillon adds weight and complexity. Both the climate and the soil, which allows excellent drainage, make growing conditions in the Central Valley in Chile ideal. *(Chile)*

Sauvignon Blanc, Topuku, Marlborough

Wonderful crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc, traditional citrus notes on the nose, inviting fresh tropical fruit flavours on the palate with a long lasting fruity finish. *(New Zealand)*

Shiraz, Murphy's

Juicy blackcurrants, some spice and just enough oak influence to balance the flavour. *(Australia)*

Merlot, Ladera Verde

Soft, round plum fruit with a ripeness that is so typical of Chile. Blended with a little Cabernet Sauvignon to give structure and length. Easy going and very pleasing. *(Chile)*

Rosé

Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ancora

A wee bottle for one person – pale coral pink, this is a fresh and fruity rosé with delicate characters of red berries and cherry. *(Italy)*

White Wines

Gewürztraminer, Dopff & Irion, Pffafenheim

Amazingly aromatic, spicy and fresh wine – full bodied with a hint of lychees. Goes superbly well with Thai food. (*Alsace*) £31.00

Riesling Trocken, Fritz Walter

A classic, slightly off-dry Riesling, with sweet lime, under-ripe pear, gooseberry and sour peach supported strongly with the steely minerality all good Rieslings need to have. (*West Germany*) £32.00

Semillon Sauvignon, Capel Vale, Margaret River

Classic blend expresses the South Western Australian cool climate. Clean, ripe, nose with lime sorbet and white flowers. Beautifully balanced with citrus fruits and herbaceous notes with a long crisp finish. (*Western Australia*) £29.00

Chenin Blanc, Cape Heights

A crisp, dry white wine with a delicate lemon colour, displaying intense floral, guava and citrus aromas and succulent tropical fruit on the palate. Unctuous and mouth filling with a long finish. (*South Africa*) £25.00

Pinot Gris, Allan Scott, Marlborough

Really soft and welcoming style. Honeysuckle, dewdrop melon and light vanilla marshmallow, like a summer stone-fruit cocktail. (*New Zealand*) £33.00

Meursault, Vallet Frères, Burgundy

Top-end, traditionally made. Meursault has rich green-gold colour and heady, lightly oaky but seductive nutty bouquet; the palate is pretty fat and buttery but cut with toasty hazelnut flavours and long mineral balance. (*France*) £77.00

Sancerre, Domaine Daulny

Fresh, spicy aromas on the nose, rich and ripe on the palate with good mineral fruit and length. (*France*) £40.00 / half £22.00

Chablis, Domaine des Manants

Made and bottled by Jean-Marc Brocard, a young and exceptionally capable wine-maker. His Chablis is of a very high standard – clean, dry and flinty with full-bodied richness. (*France*) £47.00 / half £25.00

Pouilly Fuissé, La Roche, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Collovray & Terrier

Pale gold in colour – clean, fresh, ripe fruit with a smooth, creamy texture. The palate shows complex nut and spice flavours, balanced with taut acidity. (*France*) £55.00

Sauvignon Blanc, Forrest Estate, Marlborough

Sauvignon Blanc at its very best – the flavours spring from the glass. Vibrant gooseberry aromas with a ripe concentrated palate and good weight. (*New Zealand*) £35.00

Chardonnay, C J Pask, Hawkes Bay

A lively, fruit driven, unoaked Chardonnay. Crisp citrus and green apple flavours softened with fresh pineapple. (*New Zealand*) £29.00

Albariño, Alba Vega, Rias Baixas

Rias Baixas, the birthplace of Albariño, lies at the heart of Galicia, an isolated region in the north-western corner of Spain. This is a sensational, clean tasting and lively wine. Fragrant, fruity and zesty, with an elegant, full-bodied taste. (*Spain*) £33.50

Viognier, Los Coches

Ripe and full bodied with plentiful stone fruit, citrus and a touch of honey on the finish. (*Chile*) £24.00

Picpoul de Pinet, 'Duc de Morny', l'Ormarine, Languedoc

Mouth-watering, quincy, juicy and dry with a mineral finish. A full-bodied, refreshing and delicious white wine. (*France*) £27.50

Red Wines

Malbec, Mendoza, Nieto Reserva

Black-purple in colour, with intense plum and blackcurrant fruit. Ten months spent in French oak give layers of vanilla, coffee and spice to this full-bodied wine. *(Argentina)* £31.00

Shiraz, Bremerton Selkirk, Langhorne Creek

Exceptional quality Langhorne Creek Shiraz. Bold, peppered, black fruit and sweet cassis with complex hints of cocoa beans and coconut, with great structure. *(Australia)* £32.00

Cabernet Franc, Domaine Mas Barrau

Organic Cabernet Franc from South facing vines near Nimes. Red fruit, brambles, peppery spice and softness all mashed together. *(France)* £24.00

Bella Luna Nero D'Avola, Victoria

From the family-owned McPherson vineyard, this usually sturdy Sicilian grape becomes joyful, medium-bodied, bright and juicy, with lashings of black cherry fruit, just a whisper of smoky oak and whiffs of cracked black pepper, eastern spices and violet. *(Australia)* £32.00

Shiraz, Mollydooker, The Boxer

Big and rich (16% ABV), full of spicy red fruit with a generous portion of dark chocolate on the nose; plum and cassis with hints of vanilla and oak on the palate. *(Australia)* £60.00

Beaujolais, Fleurie "La Reine de l'Arenite" la Madone

Perfumed, aromatic, medium bodied and complex, but fresh and low in tannins. Silky and elegant throughout the palate with an abundance of blackcurrant and red berry fruits. *(France)* £34.00

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Télégramme

Generous cherry and plum flavours with a long, concentrated palate. *(France)* £78.00

Beaune Premier Cru, Les Epenottes, Domaine Parent

Intense bright garnet red in colour with perfumed fruit aromas. Combines finesse and richness. *(France)* £82.00

Château Musar

Justly famous red with a cult following, an extraordinary mixture of Spanish, Italian, Rhône and Bordeaux influences in a warm, complex style of its own. *(Lebanon)* £72.00

Pinot Noir, Forrest Estate, Marlborough

Ripe red fruit flavours with underlying earthy aromas and a smoky oak finish. Medium bodied, soft, rounded and very drinkable. *(New Zealand)* £37.00

Pinotage, Kingklip Bay

A medium to full-bodied dry red, with a plum and berry fruit aroma. Soft and fruity in style but with good body and length. *(South Africa)* £24.50

Rustenberg 'John X. Merriman', Stellenbosch

A Bordeaux inspired blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. A very gorgeous, very soft and oaky, full-bodied red. *(South Africa)* £39.80

Rioja Vega Crianza

Notes of ripe fruit (blackcurrants and cherries), well integrated with toasted aromas of cinnamon, caramelised toffee and butter. This is a velvety wine with good structure and good fruit levels. *(Spain)* £29.00

Zinfandel, Scotto Family, Lodi Valley, California

Old vines give real concentration and character to the ripe red fruit, with dark chocolate, plum, cassis, vanilla and spice running along behind. *(USA)* £29.50

Bremerton Old Adam Reserve Shiraz

From the very best old-vine Shiraz blocks in Langhorne Creek, then aged in new oak for 22 months, giving an intense, rich, bold but elegant wine. Limited stock – only when available. *(South Australia)* £81.00

Vacqueyras, Domaine Grandy, Rhône

A full-bodied and flavoursome blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Spicy, smoky aromas with notes of plum and raspberry, with ripe smooth tannins and a velvety, spicy finish. *(France)* £30.50

Half Bottles

Sancerre, Domaine Daulny

Fresh, spicy aromas on the nose, rich and ripe on the palate with good mineral fruit and length. *(France)* £22.00

Chablis, Domaine des Manants, Jean-Marc Brocard

Brocard's Chablis is of a very high standard – clean, dry and flinty with full-bodied richness. *(France)* £25.00

Gewurztraminer, Cave de Turckheim, 'Cave Tradition'

Probably the best tippie with Thai food! A fragrant balance of ripeness, purity and finesse with rose, lychee, lemon and a steely flinty character. *(Alsace)* £19.00

Ontañón Rioja Crianza

Subtle aromas of black cherry, spice and voluptuous black fruit with some herbal notes. The palate has smooth, velvety tannins and fresh balancing acidity. *(Spain)* £18.00

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Galets de la Berthaud, Roger Perrin

Complex nose of red and black fruits with white pepper and a hint of vanilla. Generous palate with fine tannins and a long lingering finish. *(France)* £30.00

Château Malbat, Bordeaux

Ripe, fresh aromas with clean bright fruit and a supple finish. Made mainly from Merlot. *(France)* £23.00

Rosé Wine

Rosado Rioja, Bodegas Bagordi

Intense fruity flavour of strawberries and hints of other red berries with good acidity. A delightfully light, fresh and lively rosé. One bottle is rarely enough! *(Spain)* £25.00

Big Top Zinfandel Rosé

Medium Californian rosé wine with a pale ruby-pink colour and a red berry and peach bouquet. Fruit packed and full of strawberry ice cream flavours. Elegant and refreshing, this wine is delicious with spicy dishes. *(California)* £25.00

Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ancora

A wee bottle for one person – pale coral pink, this is a fresh and fruity rosé with delicate characters of red berries and cherry. *(Italy)* 18.7cl £8.00

Dessert Wine

Muscat de Beumes de Venise, Les Grandes Serres
